# **Description of Entity's Outcomes**

Although students' time at school was severely limited in 2022 by (1) the eruption of the Hunga Tonga-Hunga Ha'apai volcano and its accompanying tsunami, and (2) the subsequent arrival of the Covid virus in Tongatapu, the Trust's work of supporting students and ex-students financially continued. In addition to this, several donations enabled the trust to make grants to specific families who had been identified by the school leadership and being in great need as a result of the eruption and tsunami. Later in the year Trustees were able to visit the school and invest funds in renewing school equipment and textbooks.

### **Basis of Preparation**

Hornsby Pacific Education Trust is permitted by law to apply PBE SFR-C (NFP) Public Benefit Entity Simple Format Reporting - Cash (Not for Profit) and has elected to do so. All transactions are reported in the Statement of Receipts and Payments and related Notes to the Performance Report on a cash basis.

### Goods and Services Tax (GST)

The entity is not registered for GST. Therefore all amounts are stated inclusive of GST (if any).

### Income Tax

Hornsby Pacific Education Trust is wholly exempt from New Zealand income tax having fully complied with all statutory conditions for these exemptions. The Trust holds a certificate of exemption from the Inland Revenue Department.

# **Foreign Currency**

The Tongan bank account transactions have been converted from Tongan pa'anga to New Zealand dollars using the average monthly conversion rate contained in Inland Revenue Department's published tables for the period.
